Historic Sycamore Tree Planted at the High Bridge Elementary School

Planted: April 21, 2023

This tree was grown from seeds collected from the parent tree: the Valley Forge Sycamore located on the Pawling's farm portion of Valley Forge National Historic Park.

Estimated to be between 260 and 285 years old, the Valley Forge tree is a witness tree, having shared the landscape with Washington and the Continental Army from December 1777 - June 1778
