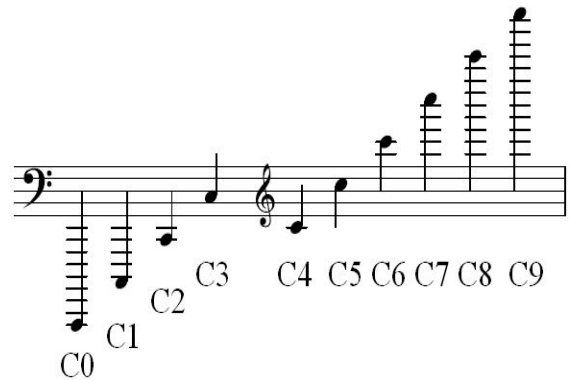

On this kid friendly website, they can compose their own original music, compete in mini-game contests, and challenges, travel through time and space to uncover musical genres, and win awards for using their musical knowledge and imagination.

On this website there are extended opportunities in which parents can add more games at a charge. Please know there is no requirement to purchase anything additional as the district purchased the program with all curriculum components needed. These additional options are various games and enrichment activities. There are plenty of games and tools which are free of charge to the students. Please be aware that there is a chat feature which will not be activated by the district but can be activated by the parents. We do not encourage you to activate it.
