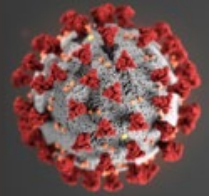

The Hunterdon County Health Department is providing case count numbers by municipality and **cannot release any additional personal information to protect case identity and privacy.** Calls to the Department seeking information that cannot be provided takes health professionals away from their vital public health and COVID response duties.

**The County Health Department performs contact tracing for each positive and probable COVID-19 case. If you have had close contact with an individual who has tested positive, you will be contacted by public health officials.**

**What is a “close contact?”**

A close contact is defined as being within approximately 6 feet (2meters) of a COVID-19 case for a prolonged period of time (approximately 10 minutes or longer); close contact can occur while caring for, living with, visiting, or sharing a health care waiting area or room with a COVID-19 case

OR Having direct contact with infectious secretions of a COVID-19 case (for example, being coughed on).
