WELCOME

OLD BUSINESS

- A. Membership Drive
 - i. No new members.
 - ii. Stays open all year.
- B. Kids Night Out
 - i. Last MS KNO was on March 1.
 - ii. High Bridge alumni who are seniors now ran the games because they didn't get to finish out because of Covid.
 - iii. They were terrific, very interactive.
 - iv. Fundraiser to help Student Leadership. We donated half of the cost of the pizza so they raised \$444.
- C. St. Patrick's Day Bingo
 - i. Held on March 15.
 - ii. Every child left with a prize.
 - iii. We held a bake sale; the fruit went well, so we should do more next year. We raised about \$260.
 - iv. Some people didn't bring money so make it more obvious on the flyer next year that we will have a bake sale, etc.
- D. Library Clean Up
 - i. On March 9, we held a library clean-up to try and get the kids back in here.
 - ii. We need more books.
 - iii. Ms. Grosky will need volunteers to help keep the library maintained. We will revisit this after the play.
 - iv. She will have to teach people how to add barcodes and scan into the system.
- E. Book Drive
 - i. We didn't get too many, so we will extend it.
 - ii. We can also have a bin outside the library at the Book Fair.
- F. Thoughts on Becoming a PTSO (Parent-Teacher-Student Organization)
 - i. We are currently a 501c4. It has different tax exemptions.
 - ii. We voted last month to put the money budgeted for the application back into teacher grants until we're ready to apply.
 - iii. To do this, we would have to dissolve the PTO and apply as a new organization for the 501c3.
 - Student Leadership is for the Middle School. Students must apply to be a representative.
 They plan events like dances, spirit days, community service events, community events
 like the tree lighting, etc. We see them continue onto student leadership in high school.

FINANCE REPORT

- A. \$18,857.06 beginning balance.
- B. Total income was \$871.00; total expenses were \$2,508.64.
- C. Ending Balance of\$17,219.42 (see finance report).
- G. Submitted annual report to the state (\$58 fee).
- H. We paid for the concessions for the play but we will get reimbursed next month. Any profit goes to the drama department.
- I. We bought teacher planners for Teacher Appreciation.
- J. We had to pay our insurance for \$465 (annually).
- K. We revised the budget and added a line item for Student Leadership. Anything on the expenses in parentheses is money we still have to spend.
- L. We still have about \$6,400 we will need to spend this year things like scholarships, teacher grants, field day, etc.
- M. We still have money left over from basketball hoops because we got them on sale, but we went over on some things like paper goods, etc.
- N. Typically, we spend more at the Elementary School than at the Middle School.
- O. We are considering new playground equipment at the Elementary School. Coleen Conroy has a company that would come out and tell you everything you need. We can put in for grants but they are difficult to get. The Borough just put in for a grant for the basketball court at Union Forge.
