• To provide all ELA students with opportunities to incorporate evidence based reading and writing skills on a daily basis on informal and formal assessments.

Objective 1.2 - Student Assessment

- To ensure middle school students are provided one open ended question on any assessment given in Social Studies, Science and Math where students will be expected to use evidence to support their answer via the high school modeled PEAS strategy.
- To provide elementary students an instructional scaffolded approach with consistency from grade K through Grade 2 to answering open ended questions in instruction and assignments and then add them to assessments in all subject areas for grade 3 and 4...

• To provide ongoing, meaningful and supportive PD opportunities for staff

Goal 2- To Implement and maintain programs that support students both socially and emotionally through a tiered approach featuring a kind and responsive environment, targeted supports and intensive interventions.

Objective 2.1 - Student Achievement

• To provide training to all instructional staff in the Nurtured Heart Approach and provide ongoing opportunities for implementation of learned social emotional skills.

Objective 2.2 - Student Achievement

• To expand the Social/Emotional learning program (Wingman for Schools) in assigned grade levels.

Objective 3.1 - Professional Development:
