2021-2022 HIGH BRIDGE VIRTUAL OT REMOTE INSTRUCTION PLAN

Note One: This plan will fulfill our obligation to the New Jersey Department of Education in regards to N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-9(C) This plan will detail our school operating structure should High Bridge School District be forced to close our campus to students.

Note Two: This plan will be implemented during a district closure lasting more than three consecutive school days due to a declared state of emergency, declared health emergency, or a directive by the appropriate health agency or officer to institute a public health related closure.

Electronic Devices: All students have a Chromebook with video/speaker capability. They will use this device to connect with the classroom teacher and will follow a modified schedule.

Broadband Issues: Students who have indicated to us that they have broadband or WIFI issues will have print-outs of their classroom materials created for them. Parents may pick up the materials in the container outside the main entrance of each building. We will continue work with NHV to provide Hotspots for students who cannot access the internet. The districts also provides parents with low cost internet options from local providers.

Meals: High Bridge will enact the food distribution protocols that it utilized when schools were closed. Meals will be provided for pick up from our Elementary School on Tuesday morning from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm and Thursday evenings between 5:00-7:00 pm. These meal packages (breakfast and lunch) will provide for several days' worth of food. As always, should a parent not be able to pick up food High Bridge School District will work with families to make other arrangements.

Length of Day: The school day will begin at 8:30 am and end at 1:15 pm Students will have time to conference with their teachers from 2:30-3:30 pm daily.
