Resources

Staff will have in and out-of-district training, and money will be allocated through Title II funding. Justification

We need to increase standardized science test scores. We will do that by targeting specific students and providing additional resources to increase compensation. Our science teacher has developed a comprehensive plan to improve comprehension.

We are standardizing our discipline practices in the middle school to decrease disruptions during instructional time. By increasing attendance and lowering tardiness, students will have additional instructional time to improve their understanding.
